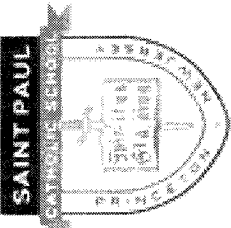

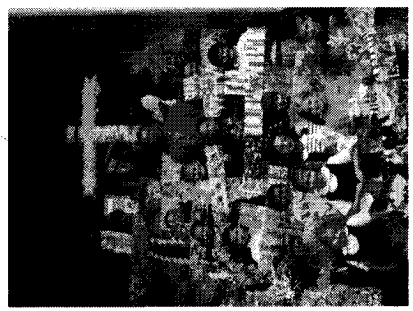

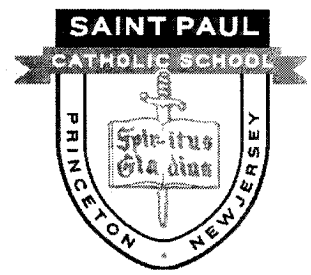

- I understand that tuition payments must be current (at least 80% paid) by February 1, 2011 in order for my child (ren) to be re-registered for the following Academic year.
- I understand that by the end of the school year, all financial and other obligations must be satisfied in full in order for my child (ren) to return to St. Paul School the following academic year.
- I agree to **participate in at least one of the fundraisers** to an amount not to exceed \$200.00, either the “10 Week Club” or the “Shamrock Auction.” Participation in both is appreciated.
- I agree to give at least **15 hours of service.** (service hours are defined in the Parent/Student Handbook)
- I agree to pay \$20.00 for each unfulfilled hour of service.

**St. Paul School bases our session staffing, supplies, and other expenses on your commitment herein.**

**Therefore, Annual Tuition is considered:**

- a. Fully obligated on December 31, 2010
- b. 75% obligated on September 30, 2010
- c. 25% obligated if withdrawal is before September 1, 2010. However SPS will consider on a case by case basis cancellation or modification of the Annual Tuition, if:
  - The student permanently relocates to a residence more than 15 miles from St. Paul School.
  - There is an unanticipated significant change in family circumstances.
  - You and the Principal of SPS agree to termination of attendance by your student.
